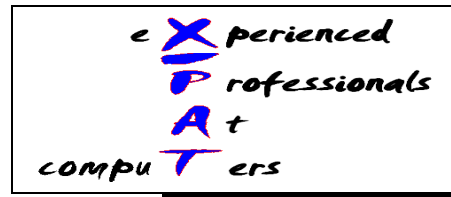

Open multiple WebPages - with one click!

Reference:

	Comment	Details
Issue:	When we start work at the beginning of the day, or we are about to commence a particular function, we often wish to look at a few WebPages.	This <i>Help moment</i> will show you how easy it is to open many specific WebPages as you want, with one click! Let the system do the work, not your fingers.
Version:	Applies to All Windows Systems.	
Recommendation:	If you have a computer less than 512MB RAM and 2.4MHz speed, do not open more than 4 pages as it may take too long.	
What is saved?	<i>Keystrokes:</i> as many as 20 every time you want to open this environment.	<i>Time:</i> you may save as much as a minute every time you want to open this 'suite' of WebPages.
So . . .	HOW DO YOU DO IT?	
Step 1:	<p><i>Save this file and modify:</i></p> <p><i>Save File:</i></p> <p>IE Multi Bat File from +UDP</p>	<p>Click on the link, and Save file to your Data Area.</p> <p>Open this sample file and modify to your requirements:</p> <p>You must keep the exact format of the 'explorer' lines. We suggest you leave the 'rem' lines so you can modify it easily at a later stage.</p>
Step 2:	Save a copy of this file into your Data area.	Saving in 'Data' will mean that it will never lose the file.

Step 3:	Change the icon to ? 	From Windows Explorer, point to the file and 'right mouse' create shortcut. Point to the shortcut, and 'right mouse' 'Properties' and 'Change Icon'. If you cannot see any icons, try looking in: <i>c:\windows\system32\shell32.dll</i> and you will find lots! I use the <i>star</i> as it reminds me of 'favorites'.
Step 4:	Put icon into Quick Launch.	Now drag this shortcut, with its new icon, to your Quick Launch Bar.
Step 5:	Do the screens open full screen?	If the IE screens do not open 'Full Screen' we suggest you 'double click' <i>ANYWHERE</i> on the 'Active Title Bar' (the blue top line). This will change the window to 'Full Screen'.
Step 6:	Is there another set you want to create?	Repeat steps 2 through 5 and give it a different name and icon.
